**Subject:** Recommended Award for Request for Proposals titled, "Strengthening Youth Partnership Pilot Project(s): Intervention Programs for Court-Involved Youth (a/k/a dependent & delinquent youth)"

Subject Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued on April 1, 2009. The deadline for receipt of applications was May 15, 2009. We received a total of six proposals. A team of five subject matter experts served as raters.

Following below are the results of the ratings as compiled by AWI:



Twin Oaks Juvenile Development, Inc. is the top-rated respondent, with a 4.6 point differential between it and second-place PACE Center for Girls, Inc. Twin Oaks Juvenile Development, Inc. has requested the maximum award amount of \$350,000, and will provide an in-kind match of \$579,540. Their proposal projects to enroll 200 trainees, all of which will complete work readiness training and of which seventy five percent will complete an occupational completion point and earn an industry recognized credential. Twin Oaks will also facilitate cross training between partners to ensure the strengthening of existing partnerships as well as improve youth grade levels at least one-grade level. The resultant average cost per youth is \$1,750.
