

# STRATEGY COUNCIL CHARTER

## ROLE

The Workforce Florida Strategy Council has three main roles:

- To develop and implement the Statewide Strategic Plan for Workforce Development in fulfillment of the Board's legislative mandate to deliver a statewide strategic plan/annual report to the Governor and Legislative leaders;
- To conduct a continuous improvement process for Florida's workforce development, including review of emerging strategic and competitiveness issues brought forward through the Partners Council, Workforce Readiness and Performance Council, and Business Competitiveness Council, and other stakeholders; and
- To create a platform for dialogue for Workforce Florida's Councils and Committees, stakeholders, and other partners.

## MEMBERSHIP

The Workforce Florida Strategy Council is chaired by a member of the Workforce Florida's Board of Directors. The members are the chairs of the Board's Councils and Committees, and include the Chair of Workforce Florida and the Partners Council Representative. The Council Chair may expand the Workforce Florida Strategy Council's membership at his or her discretion.

## OPERATIONS

The Workforce Florida Strategy Council meets as designated by the Council Chair and in coordination with Workforce Florida Board meetings. Additional meetings, whether in person or telephonic, may be conducted at the request of the Board Chair or the Council Chair.

## AUTHORITY

The Workforce Florida Strategy Council has the authority assigned to it by the Workforce Florida Board of Directors and, per the Board's legislative mandate on the strategic plan, by statute. In coordination with the President/CEO it will have the resources and authority necessary to discharge its duties and responsibilities.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

The Workforce Florida Strategy Council is charged with submitting an annual update to the Statewide Strategic Plan for Workforce Development, developing strategies that support the strategic objectives of the Statewide Strategic Plan for Workforce Development, and reviewing emerging strategic and competitiveness issues for Florida. In order to identify and prioritize issues



important to workforce development, emerging and on-going, the Workforce Florida Strategy Council facilitates meetings of workforce development stakeholders and leaders, inviting other policy experts to provide counsel at the discretion of the Council Chair. The Workforce Florida Strategy Council also facilitates the development of the Statewide Strategic Plan for Workforce Development through regional meetings to be held every three years, through issue forums, and through competitiveness and benchmarking studies.
