Senior Community Service Employment Program (SCSEP)  
*(Program Name)*

*Purpose:*

The purpose of the SCSEP is to foster and promote useful part-time work-experience opportunities in community service activities for persons with low incomes who are 55 years of age or older, who have poor employment prospects, and have the greatest economic need. Through these community service activities, the SCSEP enhances the skills and abilities of enrollees, increases their employability, develops appropriate job opportunities, and places them in unsubsidized employment after the completion of community-service work experience.

*Highlights/ Accomplishments:*

Through an Interagency Agreement between the Agency for Workforce Innovation (AWI) and the Department of Elder Affairs, the Regional Workforce Boards/One-Stops placed 395 of 723 SCSEP participants into unsubsidized employment, thus achieving 247 percent of goal (395/160 = 247%).

Effective October 1, 2002, the SCSEP was transferred back to the Department of Elder Affairs. However, the AWI and the RWBs/One Stops remain committed to assisting seniors citizens in obtaining unsubsidized employment.
