

## **Narrative Description: Toolkit for Economic Development Eligible Counties**

### Broward County (Fort Lauderdale)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of State Highway 838 and State Road 7/U.S. 441. South to State Highway 842. State Highway 842 east to the **Urban High Crime Area and Enterprise Zone boundaries**. South to Peters Road. Peters Road west to State Road 7. State Road 7 south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary to Peters Road (736)**. East to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary** to State Highway 842. State Highway 842 east to S. Andrews Avenue. S. Andrews Avenue north to the **Front Porch Community boundary**. East to US. Highway 1. U.S. Highway 1 north to State Highway 838. State Highway 838 west to the **Enterprise Zone and Urban High Crime Area boundary**. North and west to State Highway 845. State Highway 845 north to the **Enterprise Zone and Urban High Crime Area boundary**. Northwest to Interstate-95. Interstate-95 south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. West and south to State Highway 838. State Highway 838 west to State Road 7.

### Duval County (Jacksonville)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of U. S. Highway 17 and Interstate-10 (**NEED THE REST OF THE BOUNDARIES OF THE EAST SIDE OF THE ENTERPRISE ZONE. To 44<sup>th</sup> Street?**). 44<sup>th</sup> Street west to North Pearl Street. North Pearl Street north to State Highway 111. State Highway 111 west to U.S. Highway 1. U.S. Highway 1 south to U.S. Highway 23. U.S. Highway 23 east to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. South to U.S. Highway 90. U.S. Highway 90 west to McDuff Street. McDuff Street south to the **Enterprise Zone boundary**. West then south to Interstate-10. Interstate 10 east to U.S. Highway 17.

### Hillsborough County (Tampa)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of Columbus Drive and North Armenia. North Armenia south to Interstate-275. Interstate-275 east to the **Enterprise Community boundary**. South to Interstate-275/North 40<sup>th</sup> Street. North 40<sup>th</sup> Street north to the **Urban High Crime Area Boundary**. To North 34<sup>th</sup> Street. N. 34<sup>th</sup> Street to East Hillsborough Street. East Hillsborough Street west to the **Enterprise Community Boundary**. **West to the Urban High Crime Area boundary**. West to North Florida Avenue. North Florida Avenue south to West Buffalo Avenue. West Buffalo Avenue south to West Columbus Drive. West Columbus Drive west to North Armenia.

### Miami-Dade County (Central and North Dade)

The area within the boundaries of the Carol City Urban High Crime area, the Opa Locka Urban High Crime area, the Hialeah Urban High Crime area, the Opa Locka Front Porch Community, the Riverside Front Porch Community, the Miami Federal Empowerment Zone and the Liberty City Federal Empowerment Zone. The community also includes a few areas that connect these designated areas.

### Orange County (Orlando)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of Kirkman Road and McLeod Road. McLeod Road east to Rio Grande Avenue. Rio Grande Avenue south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. West then south then east to Rio Grande Avenue. Rio Grande Avenue south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. East to South Orange Blossom Trail. South Orange Blossom Trail north to Interstate-4. Interstate-4 north to Michigan Street and the **Urban High Crime Area boundary** to Orange Avenue. Orange Avenue north to Gore Street. Gore Street west to I-4. I-4 north to Colonial Drive. Colonial Drive west to the **Enterprise Zone boundary (John Young Parkway ?)**. **John Young Parkway** west to the East-West Expressway. East-West Expressway west to State Highway 526 (**Ivy Lane?**). **Ivy Lane** south to the **Enterprise Zone boundary**. West to Kirkman Road. Kirkman Road south to McLeod Road.

### Palm Beach County

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of West Blue Heron Boulevard and Interstate-95. Interstate-95 southeast to **Park Street?**. **Park Street?** east to **Nassau Street?**. **Nassau Street?** south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. South to State Highway 704. State Highway 704 east to U.S. Highway 1. U.S. Highway 1 north to the **Enterprise Zone boundary**. To East Blue Heron Drive. East Blue Heron Drive west to Old Dixie Highway. Old Dixie Highway north to the **Enterprise Zone and Urban High Crime Area boundary**. To West Blue Heron Drive. West Blue Heron Drive west to Interstate-95.

### Pinellas County (St. Petersburg)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of 49<sup>th</sup> Street North and Beach Boulevard Park. Beach Boulevard Park east to 9<sup>th</sup> Street. 9<sup>th</sup> Street south to Bayshore Drive Park. Bayshore Drive Park east to 4<sup>th</sup> Street. 4<sup>th</sup> Street north to Booker Lake Park (**9<sup>th</sup> Aveue?**). Booker Lake Park west to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. South to Bear Creek Park. Bear Creek Park west to 49<sup>th</sup> Street North. 49<sup>th</sup> Street North south to Beach Boulevard Park.

## ADDITIONAL COMMUNITIES

### Alachua County (Gainesville)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of State Highway 24 and Waldo Road. Northeast on Waldo Road to the **Front Porch Community boundary east and then south** to State Highway 26 (University Avenue) University Ave west to the intersection of State Highway 24 and Waldo Road.

### Escambia County (Pensacola)

The area within the boundaries of the Greater Pensacola Front Porch Community.

### Leon County (Tallahassee)

The area within the boundaries described as follows: beginning at the intersection of Tharpe Street and High Road. South on High Road to Brevard Street. Brevard Street

east to Tennessee Street. Tennessee Street east to Dewey Street. Dewey Street south to West Call Street. West Call Street east to Wanish Way (North Macomb). Wanish Way south to Gaines Street. Gaines Street west to Bradford Road. Bradford Road south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. West to Eisenhower Street. Eisenhower Street south to Orange Avenue. Orange Avenue east to Springhill Road. Springhill Road south to Springsax Road. Springsax Road to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. South to Ridge Road. Ridge Road east to Tropicare Street. Tropicare Street north to Tanner Drive. Tanner Drive east to Pasco Street. Pasco Street north to Orange Avenue. Orange Avenue east to Wanish Way. Wanish Way north to Canal Street. Canal Street east to Martin Luther King Drive. Martin Luther King Drive south to East Palmer Avenue. East Palmer Avenue east to Adams Street. Adams Street south to the **Urban High Crime Area boundary**. West to Martin Luther King Drive south to Palmer Avenue. Palmer Avenue east to Woodville Highway. Woodville Highway south to Orange Avenue. Orange Avenue east to Jim Lee Road. Jim Lee Road north to Magnolia Street. Magnolia Street west to Monroe Street. Monroe Street north to Gaines Street. Gaines Street west to Bronough Street. Bronough Street north to Lafayette Street. Lafayette Street east to south Duval Street. South Duval Street north to 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue. 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue east to Monroe Street. Monroe Street north to Tharpe Street. Tharpe Street west to High Road.

#### Polk County (Bartow)

The area with the West Bartow Front Porch Community.

#### Seminole County (Sanford)

The area with the Goldsboro Community, a Front Porch Community. in Sanford, FL.

### RURAL COMMUNITIES

#### Northwest Florida

The counties of Washington, Holmes, Jackson, Calhoun, Gulf, Franklin, Liberty, Gadsden, and Wakulla.

#### North Central Florida

The counties of Jefferson, Madison, Taylor, Hamilton, Suwannee, Lafayette, Dixie, Columbia, Gilchrist, Levy, Baker, Union, and Bradford.

#### South Central Florida

The counties of Hardee, DeSoto, Highlands, Okeechobee, Glades, and Hendry; the cities of Pahokee, Belle Glade, and South Bay; and the area around Immokalee included within the Round II Federal Rural Enterprise Community designation.
